Kappa Sigma Fraternity Gamma-Rho Chapter Advisory Board Expectations

Our continued growth & success as a chapter depends on the personal commitment & dedication of a select group of alumni who understand the privilege to serve & the responsibility to lead. Please review the Advisory Board Expectations and confirm that you are willing to help make a difference in our chapter.

- **Length of Service** – while we hope you will decide to serve longer, we are only looking for a commitment one year at a time.
- **Time Commitment** – while this will depend a great deal on your availability and passion, we ask that you commit at a minimum to attend one chapter meeting bi-monthly (two hours), that you are available for a monthly Advisory Board conference call (30 minutes), and that you are available to respond to occasional calls and/or emails from chapter officers or committee chairmen. Additionally, the campus will have occasional advisor meetings and we ask that you coordinate with other advisors regarding attendance (one hour a few times per year).
- **Education** – we ask that you review training materials we provide, that you review these websites (www.KappaSigma.org, www.gamma-rho.org, & www.arizona.edu), and that you attend a 2-hour workshop for our new Advisory Board members.
- **Committee Involvement** – we ask that you agree to help advise in at least one of the following areas: Alumni/ Parent Relations, Awards & Recognition, Campus & Chapter Involvement, Campus & Community Relations, Finance, J-Board & Risk Management, Member Education, Philanthropy & Service, Recruitment, Ritual, and Scholarship.
- **Financial Commitment** – we ask that you cover your travel expenses and that you help set an example by contributing at least \$50 annually to the chapter's annual fund as well as make an annual contribution to our national organization.

Our chapter will only be as strong as the leadership provided by our alumni. Your commitment to serve on the Advisory Board (no less than three and no more than nine members) will make an impact on Gamma-Rho Chapter. Thank you.
